

## RANDOLPH COUNTY ANTIQUE CLUB GARDEN TRACTOR PULLING GAMES

### General Rules:

- The driver in each class has the option to start again to re-pull.
- Drivers must be 12 years of age and be able to drive in a safe and responsible manner.
- Drivers must be with their tractors and in line while their class is being pulled.
- All tractors must be stock.
- Four-wheel drive tractors can pull, but front wheels must be in neutral or any other assist that would power the front wheels.
- If tractors raise to a point the judge's feels dangerous to the driver, workers, or spectators, the judge will stop the pull.
- Driver must stop the tractor immediately upon signal from officials.
- Tractor seat must stay in fixed position during the pull.
- All tractors must have working brakes capable of safely stopping the tractor.
- Tractor must meet all safety and shielding requirements prior to hooking or you will not be allowed to compete.
- Going out of bounds ends the pull and the pull will be marked from that spot.
- Wheel weights must be factory made. No add on front weights or chains.
- Hitch must be stationary.
- Mower decks must be disabled.
- Puller must be a club member.
- Pullers must provide clevis and hitch pin.
- These rules are for the safety of everyone, and to provide a fun and safe event.
